Victim identification & support

ACT212 operates the National Hotline against Human Trafficking and Exploitation. It receives reports of exploitative situations and forwards them to governmental and non-governmental agencies specialised in human trafficking. Trafficked individuals are put in contact with local support services.

Awareness Raising & training

ACT212 holds presentations, training courses, consulting and public events. In cooperation with experts, ACT212 raises awareness of the issue of human trafficking and sexual exploitation in Switzerland and abroad among both professionals and the general public.
